- **Creating a welcoming, accessible and comfortable public space** – A public space that is vibrant, safe and comfortable for all

Construction on the space will begin in the summer of 2025. The project will be complete in 2026.

Virtual Pre-Application Public Consultation Meeting - 35 Plains Road East

KFA Architects and Planners Inc. is hosting a virtual pre-application public consultation meeting to present their proposal for the development of the vacant lot located at 35 Plains Road East.

The proposal is for a 12-storey mixed-use building with two levels of underground parking. The building will feature 161 residential units, rooftop amenity space with views towards Lake Ontario, and high-quality commercial spaces at the ground level. The building is designed to accommodate a spacious streetscape along Plains Road East, and conceals the vehicular access within the building envelope on Cooke Boulevard.

The proposed development will require an Official Plan Amendment and a Zoning By-law Amendment to accommodate the height and density, as well as other zoning regulations. No formal application has been submitted to the City of Burlington at this time, and the City has not made any decisions on this proposal.

The proposal is still in the pre-application phase, and this community meeting has been scheduled to gain value

ble feedback from the surrounding community members on the proposed development. During this meeting KFA, on behalf of the property owners, will present the proposed development. KFA are the architectural and planning consultants for this project, and together with the property owners will be available to answer questions regarding the proposal following their presentation. City Staff will also be in attendance to provide an overview of the development application process and to moderate the meeting. Ward 1 Councillor Kevin Galbraith and Mayor Meed Ward will also be in attendance to hear the community feedback.

The City of Burlington is recommending an Official Plan Amendment and a Community Planning Permit (CPP) By-law that will affect lands within the City's three Major Transit Station Areas (MTSAs): Downtown Burlington Urban Growth Centre/Burlington GO, Aldershot GO and Appleby GO.

You are invited to attend a Statutory Public Meeting on Tuesday, June 11th concerning a city-recommended Official Plan Amendment (OPA) and Community Planning Permit (CPP) By-law. An initial Statutory Public Meeting on a draft version of the OPA and CPP By-law took place on Tuesday, October 31st, 2023, and three Open Houses were held in October 2023. City staff reviewed the comments received from the public and technical agencies and revised the draft October 2023 version of the OPA and CPP By-law. City staff are now presenting a recommended OPA and CPP By-law for further public consultation and adoption by Council.

How to Participate in the Statutory Public Meeting:

The recommended Official Plan Amendment and Community Planning Permit By-law will be available for public review on Tuesday, May 21, 2024.

The staff recommendation report, and a discussion of staff's Official Plan Amendment and Community Planning Permit By-law recommendations, will be available for public review on Friday, May 31, 2024. The report will be available on the City's website at www.burlington.ca/calendar by searching for the meeting date for the Committee of the Whole, or by visiting www.getinvolvedburlington.ca/mtsa.

The Appleby Creek Flood Mitigation Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (ACFMEA) Study was completed in February 2019. The ACFMEA study evaluated alternative solutions along Appleby Creek, from New Street to the GO Transit Rail corridor (near Appleby Go Train Station), to identify specific opportunities to reduce flooding risk and protect the natural heritage features and functions within the study corridor. The ACFMEA recommended preferred solutions for three flood-vulnerable areas within the study corridor.

For the study area north of Fairview Street (Reach 3), three options were assessed to reduce the extent of the flood hazard:

Option 1 - Do Nothing

Option 2 - Replace the existing bridge (Fairview Street) with a 17-metre span to convey the 100-year storm.

Option 3 - Replace the existing bridge with a span large enough to pass the Regional Storm

Option 2 was originally selected as the preferred alternative however, the ACFMEA File Report acknowledges that this option still results in the flooding of private property and the overtopping of Fairview Street under Regional Storm conditions. Option 2 was selected over Option 3 primarily due to the concerns of the capital cost at the time of evaluation.

Since the completion of the ACFMEA, the socio-cultural and economic environments of the study area have changed as a result of plans for land use intensification and proposed development within the vicinity of the Fairview Street crossing. As a result, the preferred solution identified in the ACFMEA for the Fairview Street crossing structure does not adequately address the flooding risks within the flood limits of adjacent development lands, specifically development lands known as Oval Court lands.

As such, the purpose of this Addendum process is to address the change of the preferred solution. The Addendum report will identify the circumstances necessitating the change to the larger hydraulic structure, and the potential environmental impacts and provide a comprehensive list of mitigative measures.

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited (Burnside) was retained by Branthaven Development Corporation to complete an addendum to the Appleby Creek Flood Mitigation Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (ACFMEA) completed by Aquafor Beech Limited for the City of Burlington in February 2019.
