Hybrid Statutory Public Meeting and Recommendation Report - 2072 Lakeshore Road

Bousfields Inc. on behalf of the landowners at 2072 Lakeshore Road have applied for an Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment to permit the development of a 20-storey (including mechanical penthouse) mixed use building. The proposed development includes 582 m² of non-residential uses on the first and second floor, as well as a mix of one-, two- and three-bedroom residential units resulting in a total of 165 units. A total of 3,907 m² of amenity space (indoor and outdoor) and 162 parking spaces within 7 levels of underground parking is proposed.

Appleby Creek Erosion Control Environmental Assessment (EA) Study completed in 2020 identified channel erosion and slope destabilization within the Appleby Creek area from South Service Road to Lake Ontario. The EA recommended erosion reduction strategies to be completed in phases.

In this phase, the City of Burlington will undertake restoration work on Appleby Creek, both upstream and downstream of Spruce Avenue. The project will include bank protection, minor channel realignment, profile corrections to enhance fish habitat, and measures to protect the Spruce Avenue bridge area.
