Amanda Martinez is a Toronto-based singer/songwriter whose music exultingly blends her unique Mexican and South African roots with flamenco soul.

She has released four albums and working on her 5th album *Momentos* for release spring 2024. Her songs have been selected for four Putumayo world music collections – Bossa nova around the world, Café Latino, Latin dreamland and Mexico.

Growing up in a bicultural household, Amanda was influenced by her father's eclectic record collection which she spent hours listening to and her trips to Mexico to visit her family. She credits her parents for sparking her love of music.

Her upcoming album *Momentos* features collaborations with Juno award winning Malagasy guitarist Donné Roberts, multi-instrumentalist Waleed Abdulhamid and Ladino singer/songwriter Aviva Chernick as well as her l

ong time band mates Kevin Laliberté (producer and guitarist), Drew Birston (bass), Rosendo “Chendy” Leon (percussion) and Alexander Brown (trumpet) Her previous albums have featured collaborations with Juno award winning singer Kellylee Evans, Grammy nominated Miami based singer Elsten Torres and Grammy winning producer Javier Limon.

Career highlights include headlining the Blue Note jazz club in NYC, the FIFA World Cup in South Africa and the Pan American Games in Mexico and Canada. She has also been a guest recording and touring artist of award-winning guitarist Jesse Cook. She has sold out Toronto’s Koerner Hall multiple times and Ottawa’s National Arts Centre and Winter Garden Theatre.

Amanda has been recognized with multiple nominations as Latin Jazz Artist of the Year (Canada’s National Jazz Awards), Best World Music Artist (Canadian Folk Music Awards) and she was the winner of Best World Music Artist (Toronto Independent Music Awards) for her debut album Sola. Her albums have reached the top 10 on iTunes World Music charts.

In addition to her music career Amanda works as an actress in film and tv including roles in Hallmark’s Two for the Win, Private eyes and The Hot Zone. Her voice may be recognized as Queen Haven on My Little Pony and Abuela on the PBS series Rosie’s rules for which she also co-composes the music.

Total Solar Eclipse at Spencer Smith Park

Date and Time: Monday, April 8 2:00 pm - 4:30 pm

Join Mayor Marianne Meed Ward and Members of Council at Spencer Smith Park to witness the total solar eclipse.

The total solar eclipse, where the moon completely covers the sun, will be visible throughout Burlington offering a unique opportunity to observe this natural wonder. The eclipse will begin in the early afternoon at 2:04 p.m. reaching full coverage at 3:18 p.m. and begin gradually dissipating, wrapping up by 4:31 p.m.

Residents are encouraged to bring lawn chairs, blankets, water and snacks.

Residents are reminded that a solar eclipse is best seen in clear weather conditions. While the City is prepared to host residents at Spencer Smith Park either way, the eclipse will not be as visible in cloudy, or rainy weather conditions.

Eclipse Eye Glasses

To help prepare spectators for this event, the City has partnered with the Department of Physics and Astronomy at McMaster University to distribute eclipse glasses for free.

Eclipse glasses will be handed out by City staff for free at Spencer Smith Park on Monday, April 8 at 11 a.m., while supplies last.

Eye Safety

- It is not safe to look at the sun without eclipse glasses. Looking at even a small sliver before or after the eclipse without eye protection can be harmful to your vision. Health impacts may include retinal burns, blurred vision, and loss of eyesight (immediate or delayed onset).
- Glasses with specialized filters adhering to the **ISO 12312-2** international standard can be worn to prevent eye damage. Glasses should be inspected for wrinkles or scratches ahead of use and should not be used if damaged/scratched.

- Parents/guardians/caregivers must supervise children at all times during the eclipse. Ensure children keep their glasses on.
- Read and follow all warnings and instructions on the inside of the eclipse glasses.
- Do not run/walk, or use a bike/scooter, skateboard or motor vehicle with eclipse glasses on.

Ministry of Health Safety Information

Travel Tips

- Motorists are reminded to drive with extra caution. If driving, have headlights turned ON for entire duration.
- While driving, avoid looking at the eclipse. Keep your eyes on the road to safely operate your vehicle and avoid collisions.
- Expect increases in traffic and road congestion. Plan ahead, fill your gas tank, and have snacks, water, entertainment, and first-aid supplies on hand.
- If travelling to view the eclipse, plan to arrive to your viewing destination early.
- Be extra mindful of distracted drivers and pedestrians.
