## Hybrid Statutory Public Meeting & Recommendation Report - 2071 Fairview Street

You are invited to attend a Public Meeting to consider the recommendation report concerning the application for 2071 Fairview Street.

Fothergill Planning and Development Inc. has made an application on behalf of a private landowner to amend the Zoning for the property located at 2071 Fairview Street (formerly known as 2089 & 2095 Fairview Street) in Ward 2. The subject land is currently designated 'Mixed Use Corridor – Commercial Corridor' in the City of Burlington Official Plan (1997, as amended) and as 'Urban Corridor' in the New Official Plan (2020). The applicable zoning of the subject lands is 'MXT-386' (Mixed-Use Transit Station Area with Site Exception 386).

The applicant is proposing to amend the Zoning By-law to permit a reduction in the minimum required office space from the previously proposed 3,220 m<sup>2</sup> to 1,009 m<sup>2</sup> in order to accommodate 24 additional apartments and provide a total of 388 apartments instead of the previously proposed 364 apartments. The building layout of the proposed plan is illustrated on the Concept Plan (see attachment).

This meeting will be held using a hybrid model, allowing members of Council, City staff and the public the option of participating remotely or in person at Burlington City Hall.

Weston Consulting has applied on behalf of the landowner to amend the Zoning By-law for the property located at 236

Plains Road East in Ward 1. The subject land is currently designated 'Residential – Medium Density' in the City of Burlington Official Plan (1997, as amended) and 'Urban Corridor' in the Official Plan (2020). The applicable zoning of the subject lands is 'Residential – Medium Density' (RM1-346).

The applicant is proposing to amend the Zoning By-law to permit the development of a 4-storey condominium townhouse block consisting of 6 units. The proposed development includes a mix of two- to three-bedroom residential units and total amenity area of 523.28 metres square. Vehicular access is proposed from Plains Road East via a two-way condominium road on west of the proposed townhouses. A total of 14 parking spaces at-grade are proposed.
